

Swishing party

How do I organise a Swishing Party?

Choose a date and house where one room can be used as a changing room. You could borrow clothes rails or just hang the clothes around a room or on the stair rails. Invite your friends to buy an entry ticket for, say £10. For this, they will get a glass of wine (or a pint of beer!) and a ticket number which will allow them to sell their clothes and buy on the night.

Before the event, give out clothes labels to all ticket holders with instructions to pre-label all their items with their ticket number, size, description and a suggested price. On the night, the host takes the proceeds and keeps the labels

from the sold items to allocate 50% to the sellers and 50% to the Macular Society.
